- Live like everything happens by and accordance to the Word of God.
 - All things were created by the Word of God (Genesis 1:3-26; Hebrews 11:3).
 - We will all be judged by the Word of God (Romans 1:32-2:16).
 - We are all saved by the Word of God (Romans 10:17).
 - We are sanctified by the Word of God (John 17:17).
- Live like the Lord desires all to come to repentance (Ezekiel 18:32; John 3:16).
 - Everyone who calls upon the Lord shall be saved (Romans 10:13).
 - He invites all to come to Him to find rest for our souls (Matthew 11:28-30).
 - For those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, He will satisfy (John 4:13; Matthew 5:6).
 - It is a free gift to all who will believe (Romans 6:23; Isaiah 55:1-3).
- Live like Jesus could come back any day.
 - He will come like a thief in the night (1 Thessalonians 5:2-3; Revelation 16:15; Matthew 24:36-44).
- Live like holiness and godliness matter.
 - Conduct yourself with obedience and fear (1 Peter 1:14-17).
 - Conduct yourself with love and freedom (1 John 5:1-3).
- Live like there is false teaching.
 - Take false teaching seriously and know the Word (2 Peter 2:1-4; Matthew 7:15-19; 2 Corinthians 11:13-15).
- Live like your leaders live.
 - (1 Corinthians 11:1; Hebrews 13:7; Philippians 3:17; 1 Corinthians 4:16-17; 1 Thessalonians 1:6-7; Hebrews 6:12; 1 Timothy 4:12; Philippians 4:9; 2 Thessalonians 3:7-9)
 - Let’s flip the “jeep” back over together:
 - Share the gospel and invite people to church.
 - Encourage the struggling Christian; get them back to church.
 - Financially give to the church.
 - Willingly serve and pursue serving opportunities.
 - Hunt down the new faces.
 - Have a great attitude.
 - Pray for wisdom for your leaders and encourage them.
 - Attend everything; Read your Bible; Pray.
 - Kill selfishness/COVID brain/Laziness. We are at war!
