God's Righteousness Romans 10:1-8

Prayer for Salvation (v. 1)

- "My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved": Because God is sovereign in salvation we should be moved to pray (Matthew 9:37-38). Paul had a deep desire to see the salvation of his people. He longed for his kinsmen to come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ (Romans 9:1-3).
 - Are we emotionally moved to prayer by the anguish and sorrow in our hearts over the condition of the lost?

Worthless Zeal (v. 2-3)

- "They have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge": Paul knew from his own experience that this was the case for the people of Israel (Acts 26:4-11; Galatians 1:13-14; Philippians 3:4-6). They had a zeal according to the knowledge of men, not the knowledge of God. Any zeal that is not based on the truth of God's Word will only lead to destruction and condemnation.
- "Ignorant of the righteousness of God... seeking to establish their own": The people of Israel, due to their lack of understanding, saw God's law as a means to gain their own righteousness. They twisted and added to God's Word in order to redeem themselves.

Saved by (Christ's) Works (v. 4-5)

- "Christ is the end of the law for righteousness": Jesus Christ is the "goal" and "termination" of the law with respect to righteousness (Romans 3:21-26; 8:1-4) We are no longer under the condemnation of the law, but the law still reveals who God is and can give wisdom to the believer (1 Timothy 1:8-11; 2 Timothy 3:16-17).
- "The person who does the commandments shall live by them": (Leviticus 18:5) God's standard is perfection (Matthew 5:48; Galatians 3:10; James 2:10). The Law of God reveals His divine holiness and our utter sinfulness (Romans 3:20). Because of our sin the Law can only bring death (Romans 7:11-12).

The Simple Message of the Gospel (v. 6-8)

- "Who will ascend... who will descend...?": (Deuteronomy 30:11-14) Paul again uses the Old Testament to show that we can do nothing to achieve salvation. Not only is it impossible to keep the Law to be saved, but we cannot complete any kind of extraordinary journey or feat to find salvation.
- "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart": God, in His grace, has revealed Himself to man. He has not hidden Himself from us (Romans 1:19-20).
- "The word of faith that we proclaim": The "word of faith" is simply God's Word; the message of salvation in Christ alone (1 Corinthians 15:1-11).
 - O Do you proclaim it to others?
