

“Everyone Who Calls Upon the Name of the LORD Will Be Saved”
Romans 10:9-13; 2 Timothy 2:19

- What does it mean to “*call upon the name of the LORD*” (Acts 2:21; Joel 2:32)?
 - You are calling upon the one true God. You are calling upon Yahweh/Jehovah (Isaiah 45:5-7; Exodus 34:14).
 - It means you are coming to God on His terms and His way. He is the only source of salvation, strength, and hope. You are worshipping/glorifying Him properly (Psalm 79:6 & 9; Psalm 105:1; Psalm 115:1; Psalm 116:4-5).
 - The salvation that is offered is an absolute guarantee (Hebrews 7:25)!
- “*For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek...*”
 - The Jews believed Christianity to be a direct attack upon their religion. They had a specific dislike towards Christianity (Acts 21:28).
 - The reconciliation bought for us by Christ, reconciles us both with God and with one another. It removes all hostility between people groups (Ephesians 2:11-16; Galatians 3:28-29).
- “*Bestowing His riches on all who call on Him...*” (Matthew 13:44-46; Ephesians 3:8)
 - Redemption through His blood; we were bought by the blood of Christ (Ephesians 1:7).
 - Forgiveness of all our sins, past, present, and future (Ephesians 1:7).
 - The knowledge of God’s Will and the ability to walk in God’s Will (Ephesians 1:8-9).
 - The sealing of the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13-14).
 - Everything that we need to live a holy life (2 Peter 1:3).
 - We are joint-heirs with Christ; God’s adopted children (Romans 8:16-17).
 - Those who trust in Christ will not be put to shame or disappointed (Titus 1:2-3).
- “*Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord....*” (1 John 4:15; Matthew 10:32-33; 1 Corinthians 12:3)
 - Jesus is Lord means I will live a life of obedience to Him (Luke 6:46-49).
 - Jesus is Lord means that He is God (John 1:1; 1 John 4:15; Jude 1:4).
 - Jesus is Lord means that He is authoritative on all things (Philippians 2:9-11).
- “*Believe/have faith in your heart that God raised Him from the dead...*”
 - What is faith or belief (Hebrews 11:1 & 6)?
 - Faith is an absolute confidence/assurance in something/someone.
 - Hope is belief in the faithfulness of God’s Word.
 - Walking in conviction is living out the Bible like it is true.
 - Faith is believing God’s Word over my feelings.
 - Faith in God is not by sight.
 - God raised Him from the dead (1 Corinthians 15:14-19).
 - Because of the resurrection we have victory over death, Hell, and the grave (1 Corinthians 15:55-57).
 - There is no intercession for us if Jesus wasn’t raised from the dead (Romans 8:34; Hebrews 7:25).
 - There is no physical resurrection for us if Jesus wasn’t resurrected (2 Corinthians 4:14).
 - Without the resurrection there is no justification (Romans 4:25).
 - Without the resurrection we cannot trust the words of Jesus (Matthew 17:22-23).
