"Through Love Serve One Another" Galatians 5:13-16,24-26

- 1. Christ did not save us to keep living for ourselves or do what we want. He saved us to die to ourselves and live for His glory.
- 2. All of us have the same capacity to love and be holy. It just will require more death, sacrifice, and discipline for some.

"But it (lord over people and use authority/power to get what you want) shall not be so among you. But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many" (Mark 10:43-45). "Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others" (Philippians 2:3-4).

- "For you were called to FREEDOM brothers...." FREEDOM from the Law:
 - Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law (Galatians 3:13).
 - We must stand against the temptation to become Legalists: to earn salvation by our works or to be made more righteous by keeping an unbiblical command (Galatians 5:1).
 - We live FREE from the Law in TOTALITY or we are BOUND to the Law TOTALLY (Galatians 5:3).
 - People are only saved by the Law being kept perfectly; either you must keep it perfectly or put your faith in the One who kept it perfectly, Christ. "For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God" (2 Corinthians 5:21). "He committed no sin, neither was deceit found in His mouth" (1 Peter 2:22).
- "Only do not use your FREEDOM as an opportunity for the flesh": (Galatians 5:16,24)
 - o Romans 8:1-13:
 - The righteous requirement of the Law has been fulfilled in us so there is now no condemnation in Christ Jesus (Romans 8:1,4).
 - There are two ways of thinking and two ways of living: fleshly or by the Spirit (Romans 8:5).
 - Fleshly: Hostile to God, does not submit to God's Law, cannot please God, conceited, envying, provoking one another, and biting, devouring, critical, negative, harsh, selfish, consuming one another; this all leads to death.
 - By the Spirit: Life, peace, serving, loving, sin-killing, self-less, and humbly dependent on the Spirit.
- "The whole Law is fulfilled in one word: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself'":
 - This FREEDOM was not given so that we can sin and let grace abound (Galatians 6:1-2) or be Law breakers without consequence. But this FREEDOM was given so we can walk or live like Christ (1 John 2:3-6).
 - o In Christ, we are no longer our own. We have been bought with a price, we no longer live for ourselves but for God's glory. (1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 1 Corinthians 10:31; 1 Peter 2:9-11).
 - The whole law was fulfilled in Christ (Matthew 5:17) and Christ is our example of how to love one another: A New Commandment! (John 13:34-35)
 - Just as Christ has loved us, we are to love one another. This is the premiere distinction of Christianity!

- o 1 Corinthians 13:1-3: The Supremacy of Love.
 - Without love, skill and eloquence in preaching and teaching means nothing.
 - Without love, getting theology correct means nothing.
 - Without love, great faith means nothing.
 - Without love, sacrifice and martyrdom means nothing.
