 - 2) I am not more wise than God.
 - 3) God's blessings toward me are abundant.
 - 4) What a privilege it is to serve God.
 - 5) What is hard or impossible for me is easy for God.
 - God's Character:
 - Eight things we discover about God in David's prayer:
 - 1) God does what He does based on His Word and His perfect will and desires.
 - 2) Yahweh is the only God. There is no other God.
 - 3) God does great and awesome things.
 - 4) God speaks to humanity through His Word.
 - 5) God's Word is true and He does what He has promised.
 - 6) It pleases God to bless His people.
 - 7) We have a God that redeems us.
 - 8) God knows us.
 - God's Faithfulness:
 - God is faithful for His Name's sake, according to His promise, according to His wisdom, according to His power, through His people.
 - Walking Worthy:
 - We never assume that God will do what He is going to do without our participation. Though He has made us worthy, He expects us to walk worthy. Though He does what He does for His glory, He commands us to glorify Him. Though He is faithful to His promises, He commands us to pray and walk in His promises. He does not want us to presume on His goodness or to sin presumptuously because of what He has promised to do.
