

“The Only God Who Saves”
2 Samuel 22:1-23:7; Psalm 18:1-50

“And there is no other god besides Me, a righteous God and **a Savior**; there is none besides Me. Turn to Me and **be saved**, all the ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other.” (Isaiah 45:21b-22)

“Consequently, He is able to **save to the uttermost** those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.” (Hebrews 7:25)

- The Divisions of David’s Song of Deliverance:
 - Our God is worthy to be praised (2 Samuel 22:1-4).
 - I am helpless to save myself (2 Samuel 22:5-7,17-20).
 - *“Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!” (Romans 7:24-25a)*
 - Our God is Awesome, Terrifying, and Just in His dealings (2 Samuel 22:8-16).
 - *“I hear, and my body trembles; my lips quiver at the sound; rottenness enters into my bones; my legs tremble beneath me.” (Habakkuk 3:16a; cf. Hebrews 12:18-21,28-29)*
 - God is Glorified as Trustworthy when we live according to His Word (2 Samuel 22:21-37).
 - *“What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him graciously give us all things?” (Romans 8:31-32)*
 - God’s Wrath towards sin is Final and Just (2 Samuel 22:38-46).
 - *“Since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His might.” (2 Thessalonians 1:6-9)*
 - Our praise is a Testimony to the world that our God saves (2 Samuel 22:47-51).
 - *“Oh give thanks to the LORD; call upon His name; make known His deeds among the peoples (nations)! Sing to Him, sing praises to Him; tell of all His wondrous works!” (Psalm 105:1-2)*
 - God uses men to bless men (2 Samuel 23:1-7).
 - *“For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and of peace there will be no end.” (Isaiah 9:6-7a)*
