## "The Most Important Question You Will Ever Be Asked" Luke 6:46-49; 2 Peter 1:8-10

"The Christian life is a daily *crisis of commitment*." (Who is my Lord?)

- What does it mean that "Jesus is Lord"?
  - o To have "Lordship" is to have supreme power or rule over someone or something or both.
    - "The earth is the LORD's and the fullness of thereof, the world and those who dwell therein" (Psalm 24:1). "Our God is in the heavens; He does all that He pleases" (Psalm 115:3). "All things were created through Him (the source of all things) and for Him (the aim of all things). And He is before all things (eternal), and in Him all things hold together (He sustains all things)" (Colossians 1:16b-17).
  - "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves" (James 1:22). "Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him" (John 3:36).
    - To submit to the Lordship of Christ is a lifestyle of "coming to Him", "hearing Him", and "obeying Him".
- Jesus knows EVERYTHING. We cannot fool Jesus.
  - "Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs that He was doing. But Jesus on His part did not entrust Himself to them, because He knew all people and needed no one to bear witness about man, for He Himself knew what was in man." (John 2:23-25; cf. Matthew 7:21-23)
- People will SEE what is true.
  - Luke 6:43-45
    - What is produced out of our lives is a glimpse into the reality of our hearts.
    - What we treasure, or what is important to us, or what we prioritize is a glimpse into the reality or treasury of our hearts.
  - Luke 6:46-48
    - "Building a house" = "comes to Christ"
    - "Who dug deep" = "hearing His words"
    - "Laid the foundation" = "obeys the words of Christ"
    - "When the flood arose" = (Luke 6:20-23,29-30)
    - "Could not shake it" = (Luke 6:43-45)
    - "It had been well built" = (Luke 6:46-47)

"When the stream broke against it, immediately it fell, and the **ruin of that house was great**." (cf. Luke 8:11-15)
