"The New Heaven and the New Earth: *The Millennial Reign of Christ*" (Part 1) Revelation 20:1-7

• The Breakdown of the Book of Revelation:

- The Church Age (Revelation 2-3)
 - The Rapture (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:50-54)
- The Great Tribulation (Revelation 6-18)
- The 2nd Coming (Revelation 19)
- The Millennial Kingdom (Revelation 20)
- The Eternal State (Revelation 21-22)

Revelation 20:1-7

- The time period of "one thousand years" is mentioned 6 times in these 7 verses. There is no reason in the text to interpret this in any way other than a literal one thousand years.
- Even though this angel is not given a name, most theologians believe this is *Micheal the archangel* (Jude 1:9; Revelation 12:7-8; Daniel 10:12-13).
- The bottomless pit or *the Abyss*, Biblically, is a place of punishment for demons (Luke 8:31).
 Some demons are never released from the Abyss until their final judgment (Jude 1:7; 2 Peter 2:4); others are released during the events of Revelation 9:1-12.
 - The *chaining of Satan* is very significant due to him being "the god of this world" (2 Corinthians 4:4); that the whole world lies in his power (1 John 5:19); and that he will no longer be free to "prowl around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour" (1 Peter 5:8).
- "Then I saw thrones and those seated on them...."
 - The apostles will reign with Christ in Israel (Matthew 19:28).
 - The Church will reign with Christ over the nations of the earth (Luke 22:28-30; 1 Corinthians 6:2; Revelation 2:26; 5:10).
 - Israel will enjoy the blessings promised by the prophets (Isaiah 2:1-5; 35:1-10).
- "They came to life and reigned with Christ...."
 - This is where the Tribulation saints and most likely the Old Testament Saints receive their glorified bodies (Daniel 12:1-2). They will also reign with Christ in some way.
 - "The rest of the dead" are the wicked dead talked about in Revelation 20:13-15.
- The *first resurrection* is simply the resurrection of all the saints of all the ages. There are in general two resurrections, the resurrection of the just or the unjust, a resurrection of life or judgment (John 5:28-29).
- "They will be *priests* of God and of Christ...."
 - This means we will lead people to worship God and grow in their knowledge of God.
