"The New Heaven and the New Earth: *The Millennial Reign of Christ*" (Part 2) Hebrews 2:5-8; Romans 11:11-12, 25-27

- Proof Texts in the New Testament of a Physical, Millennial Reign of Christ:
 - Jesus will reign on David's Throne over the house of Jacob (*Luke 1:32-33*).
 - The house of Jacob is Israel physically, not spiritually (Exodus 19:3-4). This was the expectation of the Old Testament saints.
 - Israel will be saved from their physical enemies (*Luke 1:68-75*).
 - Israel physically is in mind here. This physical, literal deliverance, was the proper Biblical expectation for the Jewish people (*Jeremiah 23:5-6*; 33:15; *Matthew 19:28*).
 - Israel was blessed physically and Nationally when they were obedient to God's Word (Deuteronomy 8; *Jeremiah 32:38-42*).
 - Jesus will bring the redemption of the city of Jerusalem (Luke 2:38).
 - This again is a pointing to the fulfillment of the Covenants. This is also reminding us of the importance of physical Jerusalem in God's future plans (**Zechariah 14:4-5,8-9; cf. Acts 1:11**).
 - There is a physical and a spiritual kingdom (*Matthew 4:17*).
 - We have access to the spiritual kingdom and someday the Millennial reign of Christ by faith and repentance (*Micah 4:2-5*; Zechariah 14). *Luke 19:11-27* is a great parable explaining these two aspects of the Kingdom.
 - The earth or the land is to be inherited by those that are saved (Matthew 5:5).
 - The unrighteous will not inherit the future kingdom, in fact they will be removed from the earth (*1 Corinthians 6:9*; Revelation 20:13-15).
 - All things are ours in Christ (*1 Corinthians 3:21-23*). We will rule and reign on the earth with Christ (Revelation 5:10).
 - The kingdom will be on earth (Matthew 6:10).
 - Jesus has authority to restore the physical (disease, death, and nature) Matthew 8 & 9
 - Jesus showed His authority, not only over the spiritual plight of sin, but also over the physical consequences of sin.
 - There will be eating and feasting in the kingdom (Luke 22:14-23; *Matthew 8:10-12*; Isaiah 25:6-8).
 - Luke 14:18: "Until the Kingdom of God comes"; Matthew 8:10-12: "Gentiles will be a part of the future kingdom".
 - After 40 days of instruction about the kingdom, the disciples asked about the physical kingdom (Acts 1:3,6; 3:21).
 - The creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption (Romans 8:19-22).
 - All things will be reconciled through Christ, both physical and spiritual (Colossians 1:15-20).
 - All things are not under the physical reign of Christ yet (*Hebrews 2:5-8*).
 - Man was created to rule the earth (Genesis 1:26-28). At the fall that dominion was given over to the angels, namely Satan (1 John 5:19) and yet that dominion will be taken from him by Christ and we will rule and reign with Christ (Revelation 5:10).
 - We shall reign on the earth with Christ (Revelation 5:10, 20:6).
