"The Generational Sin of **Wordlessness:** The Need for Bible-Centric Christians" 2 Timothy 3:16-4:5

"A Christian must study, memorize, meditate on, prioritize, and practice the Word of God. Through the Word of God the Holy Spirit saves us, sanctifies us, guides us, encourages us, gives us a sound mind, and grows us in wisdom. There is no greater need for the sinner or the saint than the Word of God."

"Every word of God proves true; He is a shield to those who take refuge in Him. **Do not add to His words**, lest He rebuke you and you be found a liar" (Proverbs 30:5-6). "Therefore I testify to you this day that I am innocent of the blood of all, for I did not shrink from **declaring to you the whole counsel of God**" (Acts 20:26-27).

"Behold, the days are coming,' declares the Lord God, 'when I will send a famine on the land — not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD. They shall wander from sea to sea, and from north to east; they shall run to and fro, to seek the word of the LORD, but they shall not find it." (Amos 8:11-12)

- 2 Timothy 3:16-4:5
 - All Scripture, every word is breathed out by God. God has spoken and spoken with clarity.
 - o *All Scripture* is profitable (sufficient). We have what we need from God!
 - *Teaching:* Knowing and doing.
 - Reproof: Addressing sin in people's lives.
 - Correction: To work properly or by design.
 - *Training:* To mature and develop.
 - The Word of God is to be preached in light of future judgment: "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil." (2 Corinthians 5:10)
 - The Word of God is to be preached when it is popular and when it isn't; when you are tired or refreshed; when you feel like it or not.
 - Reprove, rebuke, exhort: Deal with the whole of a person; their feelings, their mind, and their will. Use encouragement and correction.
 - "The goal of the pastor is to afflict the comfortable and to comfort the afflicted."
 - The Word of God is to be preached patiently. As God is patient with us, we must be patient with people.
 - The Word of God divides! People will have no tolerance of the truths of the Word of God. There will be resistance to certain truths from God's Word.
 - Be Faithful:
 - Think rightly when emotions are high.
 - Live rightly when times are hard.
 - Evangelize even when no one wants to listen.
 - Finish the race that you have started.
