

“The New Heaven and the New Earth: **The Great White Throne Judgment**”  
Revelation 20:11-15; Romans 2:4-5,8

“For nothing is hidden that will not be made manifest, nor is anything secret that will be known and come to light.” (Luke 8:17)

- What this is not....
  - This is not the **Sheep and Goats Judgment** (Matthew 25:31-46).
  - This is not the **Judgment Seat of Christ** (2 Corinthians 5:9-10; 1 Corinthians 3:10-15).
    - The **Great White Throne Judgment** will take place between the Millennial Reign of Christ and the **Eternal State**.
  
- What is the application of this study?
  - 1) God is Just.
  - 2) We can freely love and forgive.
  - 3) We need to share the gospel.
  - 4) No one gets away with sin or injustice.
  
- **The Great White Throne Judgment:**
  - There is a resurrection of life (glorification) and a resurrection of judgment (John 5:28-29; Acts 24:15).
  - The judge is Jesus Christ. All authority to execute judgment has been given to the Son from the Father (John 5:22-23).
  - Only unbelievers are being judged at the Great White Throne Judgment. No believers will be judged at this judgment.
  - The books that are open will have every detail about every unbeliever that has ever lived.
  - There will be differing degrees of punishment at this judgment....
    - Matthew 12:36-37: **Words** will be a part of the judgment.
    - Matthew 11:21-24; Luke 12:47-48: **Revelation** will be a part of the judgment.
    - Mark 12:38-40: **Empty religion** that misrepresented God will be a part of the judgment.
    - Romans 2:8: **Behaviors** will be a part of the judgment.
    - Romans 2:16: **Secret thoughts** and behaviors will be a part of the judgment.
  - From Christ's presence the earth and sky fled away. The purpose for the “old” earth and heaven are finished. They will be cleansed by fire (2 Peter 3:11-13).
  - This is an eternal judgment, not a temporal judgment (Matthew 25:46; Daniel 12:2; Jude 1:13; Revelation 14:10-11).
