"The Generational Sin of **Loveless Love**: What is Love Biblically?" 1 John 4:7-8

"For the Christian, there is no more important subject matter than the subject of love. We must know what the Bible says about love because, 'if I have not love, I gain nothing.' (1 Corinthians 13:3)"

"The aim (goal) of our charge (Paul's teaching and instruction) is love that issues from a pure heart (a heart that has been changed and desires obedience) and a good conscience (a life that desires to not sin against God or man) and a sincere faith (a true trust in God)." (1 Timothy 1:5)

"Beloved (those loved by God), let us love one another (command), for (because) love is from God (the source of love), and whoever loves (like this) has been born of God (been regenerated) and knows God (deep communion, intimacy, or abiding in Him). Anyone who does not love (a love of the will that is self-sacrificing towards those in need of it) does not know God (deep communion, intimacy, or abiding in Him), because God is love (God defines love, He is not defined by love)."

Setting the stage:

- Knowledge without love produces pride and immaturity; Knowledge with love produces humility and maturity (1 Corinthians 8:1-3).
- There is no more sure test of being a Christian than loving one another Biblically.
- Biblical love is not just failing to do evil towards someone, it is also succeeding in doing good towards someone.
- Since God defines love, there is true love and false love.

Defining Biblical Love:

- Biblical love looks to Christ for its example. Christ gives us the grace to walk as He walked and talk as He talked (John 13:34-35; 1 John 2:4-6).
- Biblical love is a love that disciplines and corrects (Hebrews 12:5-11).
- Biblical love is a love of sacrifice and service (1 John 3:16-18).
- Biblical love is a love that covers and forgives sin, and keeps no record of wrong (1 Peter 4:8; Ephesians 4:32; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
- Biblical love shows itself in obedience towards God. Obedience that flows from being loved by God and the desire to serve others (1 John 5:2-3).
- Biblical love does not insist on its own way. It is patient and humble (1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
- Biblical love is committed to the truth. Love is never ashamed of the truth (Ephesians 4:15; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
