## "The Generational Sin of **Spiritual Compromise:** We Must Contend For the Faith" Jude 1:3-4,17-23

Truth spoke without love is dangerous;
Truth spoke in pride is dangerous;
Lies spoken lovingly are dangerous;
Lies spoken in humility are dangerous;
Truth spoke in love and humility is glorious.

- There are three conditions a Christian can be in:
  - Humble and eager to grow. (James 3:13-17)
  - Half-hearted and unresponsive. (2 Peter 1:8-10)
  - Resistant and defensive. (Titus 3:9-10)
- There are two kinds of "being contentious":
  - A carnal disposition to be quarrelsome or argumentative.
  - A striving to debate, persuade, and protect someone out of love, due to someone being in spiritual danger.
- Jude 1:1,23-24: Our salvation is secure.
  - This is the basis of our contention. We want people to have a secure, true salvation.
- Jude 1:3-4,18-19: The Problem
  - We are called as Christians to contend (agonize) for the faith (the whole of the Apostolic teaching).
  - Certain people have crept in unnoticed (2 Corinthians 11:13-15; cf. Jude 1:4,8,12,16).
    - They are ungodly people; they defile the flesh.
    - They pervert the grace of our God.
    - They deny the Lordship of Christ; they reject authority.
    - They are worldly people.
    - They are devoid of the Holy Spirit; relying on their dreams.
- Jude 1:17,20-23: How do we contend for the faith?
  - Remember that there will be false teaching within the church.
  - False teachers will not get away with their false teaching (Jude 1:13-15).
  - Build yourself up in Biblical Doctrine; Get as much from the local church as you can.
  - Pray according to the Word of God. Pray, Pray, Pray.
  - o Live a life of holiness and obedience to the Word.
  - Live with eternity in mind.
  - Have mercy on those who doubt by being patient, loving, and Biblical in your correction.
  - The level of danger has to do with the urgency of the situation. Some situations are incredibly dangerous.
  - We must be careful with false teaching and remember that we are not above being deceived.
  - We must hate sin in our lives so that we will be useful to help others fight sin.
