Spirit-Controlled Speech: How to Glorify God with our Tongue James 3:1-12

Warning to Teachers: James 3:1

The first verse of our text is a warning to would-be teachers. We will stand in account for our teaching (Hebrews 13:17)

This is not to discourage those who would be teachers from becoming them, but instead to consider the weightiness and seriousness of the position! The manner and content of which we speak matters. James 1:19-20 tells us that "every person (not just teachers) should be quick to hear (or listen) slow to speak and slow to anger. For the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God."

Our Speech is a Sign of Our Maturity: James 3:2

"Perfect" is referring to Spiritual Maturity. There is no one but Christ who walked this earth that was perfect (1 John 1:8) "To the degree that our holiness approaches that of Christ's, to that degree we are spiritually 'perfect' or mature" - John MacArthur

- "Whoever says he abides in Him ought to walk in the same way in which He walked" 1 John 2:6
- Jesus links the **heart** and the **mouth** together (Matthew 15:11, Luke 6:45). Our **deeds** will follow suit (Proverbs 18:6)

The Power of the Tongue: James 3:3-5a

The tongue has the power to *steer and control*. Both an out of control horse or an out of control ship has the potential to hurt not only you, but many people! (Proverbs 18:21)

Example: Hymenaus, Alexander and Philetus (1 Timothy 1:19-20, 2 Timothy 2:16-18). They made a *shipwreck* of their faith through *irreverent babble* and *talk that spread like gangrene*. (False teaching).

Ways for believers to stumble in their speech:

- 1. Gossip (Proverbs 18:22)
- 2. Slander (Ephesians 4:31-32)
- 3. Crude talk (Ephesians 4:29)

The Destructive Nature of the Tongue: James 3:5b-6

The tongue is talked about as a *fire* (which can be both beneficial and harmful). Recklessness with fire can cause permanent damage. The same can be said with our tongue. "...staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life, and set on fire by hell" (vs.6)

The Restlessness and Hypocrisy of the Tongue: James 3:7-12

- God has given man every creature to have dominion over, but the tongue eludes our control.
- We see the contrasting nature of our tongue. One minute Peter was confessing Christ as the Son of God (Matt 16:16) and the next he was denying Christ (Matt 26:74-75)

Spirit-Controlled Speech

Prayer (Psalm 51:10, Psalm 141:3 Psalm 19:14), meditating on God's word (Phil 4:8), loving our brothers and sisters in Christ (Galatians 6:10) and remembering the fact that we are representing Christ to a lost world should aid us in controlling our speech! (Colossians 4:5-6)
