The Preparation and Responsibility of the "Watchman" Ezekiel 3:4-21

"God being who and what He is, and we being who and what we are, the only thinkable relation between us is one of **full Lordship** on His part and **complete submission** on ours." (A.W. Tozer)

"Thus says the LORD: 'Stand by the roads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls. But they said, 'We will not walk in it'. I set watchmen over you, saying, 'Pay attention to the sound of the trumpet!' But they said, 'We will not pay attention.' Therefore hear, O nations, and know, O congregation, what will happen to them. Hear, O earth; behold, I am bringing disaster upon this people, the fruit of their devices, because they have not paid attention to My words; and as for My law, they have rejected it." (Jeremiah 6:16-19; cf. 2 Samuel 18:24-27)

"Say to them, 'As I live, declares the Lord God, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live; turn back, turn back from your evil ways, for why will you die, O house of Israel?" (Ezekiel 33:11)

- The Preparation of the "Watchman": (Ezekiel 3:4-15)
 - The problem is not an informational problem, it is a defiance problem (Ezekiel 3:4-7; cf. Ezekiel 2:1-4).
 - God will provide what is needful to Ezekiel, so that he can do the task he has been given by
 God (Ezekiel 3:8-11; cf. Ezekiel 2:5-10)
 - **Receive** the Word into your heart (Ezekiel 2:8-3:3).
 - **Proclaim** the Word to the people (Ezekiel 3:4).
 - **Persevere** despite the reaction of the people (Ezekiel 3:8-11).
 - **Be burdened** for the people (Ezekiel 3:14-15).
 - Remember God's glory, power, and providence (Ezekiel 3:12-13).
- The Responsibility of the "Watchman" (Ezekiel 3:16-21)
 - God is both the threat and the solution for the threat!
 - "But his blood I will require at your hand."
 - "....testifying to the Jews that the Christ was Jesus. And when they opposed and reviled him, he shook out his garments and said to them, 'Your blood be on your own heads! I am innocent.'" (Acts 18:5-6)
 - "Therefore I testify to you this day that *I am innocent of the blood of all*, for *I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole counsel of God*." (Acts 20:26-27)
 - o "But if you warn the wicked...."; "But if you warn the righteous...."
 - "Whenever you hear a word from My mouth you shall give them warning from Me."
 - "He shall die for his iniquity."
 - "In order to save his life."
 - "You will have delivered your soul."
