"Then the LORD said to him, 'Who has made man's mouth? Who makes him mute, or deaf, or seeing, or blind? Is it not I, the LORD?'" (Exodus 4:11). "He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away" (Revelation 21:4).

- "Now when Jesus returned, the crowd welcomed Him....": Jesus always has people in mind in His coming and going. They wanted miracles, Jesus was acting to save and sanctify.
- "And there came a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue....": The synagogue was the epicenter of Jewish religious life. He would have been rich, a respected leader, and associated with the scribes and pharisees.
- "And there was a woman who had had a discharge of blood....": This woman would have been poor, ceremonially unclean, and therefore a social outcast.
- "For he (Jairus) had an only daughter, about twelve years of age....there was a woman who
 had a discharge of blood for twelve years....she could not be healed by anyone."
- "And falling at Jesus' feet, he (Jairus) implored Him to come to his house....and when the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came trembling, and falling down before Him..."
- "Daughter (of God), your faith has made you well (salvation/sozo); go in peace (you can enjoy God again)....Do not fear; only believe, and she will be well."
- "And her parents were amazed, but He charged them to tell no one what had happened." (cf. Mark 8:30-31)

Jesus knew miracles, instead of His message being talked about, could lead to people desiring a temporary fix instead of an eternal fix, a temporary delight instead of an eternal delight. (cf. John 5:3-5,14)
