"Then They Will Know That I Am the Lord" Ezekiel 5:1-4; 6:1-14

"The *sorrows* of those who run after another god *shall multiply*" (Psalm 16:4a). "Those who pay regard to vain idols *forsake their hope of steadfast love*" (Jonah 2:8). "Yet you have forsaken Me and served other gods; therefore I will save you no more. Go and cry out to the gods whom you have chosen; let them *save you in your time of distress*" (Judges 10:13-14). "And there is no other god besides Me, a righteous God and a Savior; there is none besides Me. *Turn to Me and be saved, all the ends of the earth*! For I am God, and *there is no other*" (Isaiah 45:21b-22).

"But you, O mountains of Israel, shall shoot forth your branches and yield your fruit to my people Israel, for they will soon come home. *For behold, I am for you*, and I will turn to you, and *you shall be tilled and sown*" (Ezekiel 36:8-9; cf. Ezekiel 36:1-15). "That the creation itself will be *set free from its bondage to corruption* and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now" (Romans 8:21-22).

- "And you shall know that I am the LORD, when their slain lie among their idols and around their altars, on every high hill, on all the mountaintops, under every green tree, and under every leafy oak, wherever they offered pleasing aroma to all their idols."
 - The mountains were where Israel practiced idolatry. (*Leviticus 26:30-33*; Isaiah 65:7; Jeremiah 3:6)
 - There was also Baal worship that took place in the valleys. (Isaiah 57:5; Jeremiah 2:23; 7:31-32)
 - When Judah had godly kings they would tear down these places of idolatry, but Israel would return back to their idols. (2 Kings 18:4; **23:4-5**)
- "And say, 'You mountains of Israel, hear the word of the LORD God.'"
 - The land (and the earth) is the Lord's and is used for the Lord's purposes. (*Leviticus 18:24-28*; 25:23)
- "Yet I will *leave some of you* alive...."
 - The people of Jerusalem will either die from the sword, from disease, or from famine. But God will save a remnant so that His purposes for Israel are accomplished. This is because of grace and mercy. (*Ezekiel 5:1-4*; 6:12)
 - **A Remnant** (a leftover amount from a larger portion or piece) has been a normative practice in God's economy. (Isaiah 10:20-21; 1 Kings 19:18; Matthew 7:13-14; **Romans 9:27-28; 11:4,26**)
- "How I have been broken over *their whoring heart* that has departed from Me and over their eyes that go whoring after other idols."
