"Living for the Glory of God?" Luke 10:1-11,17-20

"And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." (Matthew 28:18-20)

- Luke 10:1-11,17-20
 - "After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them on ahead of Him....":
 - There were 72 people who were willing to practice the words of Luke 9:23.
 - The Law required two or three witnesses to confirm any matter (Deuteronomy 19:15).
 - "Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest....":
 - Believers need a genuine concern and brokenness over the condition of the unbeliever.
 Without proclaimers there is no proclamation (Romans 10:13-17).
 - Love and prayer are essential aspects of sharing the gospel.
 - "Behold I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves...."
 - This mission was dangerous and it depended on Christ to protect, give provision, and give success.
 - "And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest upon him...."
 - A "son of peace" is someone who is willing to hear the gospel and accept the gospel.
 - Every person is either at peace with God or an enemy of God (Romans 5:9-10).
 - It is a believer's responsibility to meet the financial and provisional needs of those who work at teaching and preaching God's Word. But everyone has the responsibility of making disciples.
 - "Heal the sick in it and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you...."
 - The *spiritual rule* of God in our lives through repentance (Mark 6:12).
 - The *sovereign rule* of God over all things (Matthew 10:7-8).
 - The *physical rule* of Christ during His Millennial Reign.
 - Being rejected is a real possibility in sharing the gospel. We must be prepared for this.
 - "Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet we wipe off against you...."
 - This was a public declaration to the people of that town that they had rejected Jesus and His message. They had chosen to be an enemy of the King.
 - *"The Seventy-two returned with joy...."*
 - The greatest work of God is the salvation of a soul. Our names have been written and stand written in heaven. Our salvation is guaranteed.
