• The message of the princes of the people.

- "Son of man, these are the men who devise iniquity and who give wicked counsel in this city."
 (Ezekiel 11:2)
- "Is not the time near to build houses....to us this land is given for a possession." (Ezekiel 11:3.15)
- "The city is the cauldron, and we are the meat." (Ezekiel 11:3)
 - In ancient Israel the choice cuts of meat were cooked in a pot over the fire. The poorer pieces of meat would be cooked over the fire or discarded.
- "For I know the things that come into your mind." (Ezekiel 11:5)

- "Ah, Lord God! Will You make a full end of the remnant of Israel?" (Ezekiel 11:13b; cf. Ezekiel 9:8)
- "Though I removed them far off among the nations, and though I scattered them among the countries, yet I have been a sanctuary to them for a while in the countries where they have gone." (Ezekiel 11:16)
- God's grace:
 - "I will gather you and assemble you."
 - "I will give you the land of Israel."
 - "I will remove all of its detestable things and all its abominations."
 - "I will give them one heart and a new spirit I will put within them.
 - "I will remove their heart of stone from their flesh and give them a heart of flesh."
 - "They will walk in My statutes and keep My rules and obey them."
