

“Woe to You, America”  
Luke 10:12-16

“I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ.” (Romans 9:2-5a)

- A Gentile city that did repent: Nineveh.
  - *“Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and call out against it, for their evil has come up before Me.” (Jonah 1:2)*
  - *“And the people of Nineveh believed God. They called for a fast and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them to the least of them.” (Jonah 3:5; cf. Luke 10:13)*
  - *“When God saw what they did, how they turned from their evil way, God relented of the disaster that He had said that He would do to them, and He did not do it.” (Jonah 3:10)*
  
- Matthew 11:20-24
  - *“Then He began to denounce the cities where **most of His mighty works had been done**, because **they did not repent**.”*
  - *“For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. But I tell you that **it will be more tolerable** on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom than for you.*
  
- Luke 20:46-47
  - *“Beware of **the scribes**, who like to walk around in long robes, and love greetings in the marketplaces and the best seats in the synagogues and the places of honor at feasts, who devour widows’ houses and for a pretense make long prayers. **They will receive the greater condemnation**.”*

  - *“And the servant **who knew his master’s will but did not get ready or act according to his will**, will receive a **severe beating**. But the one **who did not know**, and **did what deserved a beating**, will receive a **light beating**.*
  - *“Everyone to whom much was given, of him much will be required, and from him to whom they entrusted much, they will demand the more.”*
