"Love: How Deep the Father's Love For Us" Luke 15:11-24

"So that Christ <u>may dwell</u> in your hearts through faith — that **you, being <u>rooted</u> and <u>grounded</u> in love**, may have strength <u>to comprehend</u> with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to **know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge**, that you may be filled with all the <u>fullness</u> of God."

(Ephesians 3:17-19)

- How do we measure the depth or the greatness of an expression of love?
 - Has this love been earned or deserved by the recipient?
 - "Christ died for the **ungodly**. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die but God shows His love for us in that while we were **still sinners**, Christ died for us....while **we were enemies**." (Romans 5:6-10)
 - o How much is sacrificed so that this love can be known and experienced?
 - "Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends" (John 15:13). "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sake He became poor, so that you by His poverty might become rich" (2 Corinthians 8:9).
 - How much delight and benefit comes from this love being lavished on us?
 - "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but **have eternal life**" (John 3:16). "You make known to me the path of life; in Your presence there is the **fullness of joy**; at Your right hand are **pleasures forevermore**" (Psalm 16:11).
 - o How strong is the desire of the Lover to do good towards the object of His love?
 - Luke 15:11-24
 - His Father saw him and *felt compassion* and *ran* and *embraced him* even though he had squandered his property in reckless living.
 - Bring quickly the best robe....put a ring on his hand and shoes on his feet.
 - And bring the fattened calf and kill it and let us eat and celebrate.
 - "He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities....as far as the east is from the west, so far does He remove our transgressions from us." (Psalm 103:10,12)
 - o Two last reflections:
 - We are aiming to know God's love and to experience God's love to its fullest. "God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." (Romans 5:5)
 - We need God's help in enjoying and savoring and experiencing His love. "May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God and to the steadfastness of Christ."
 (2 Thessalonians 3:5)
