"Living With a Biblical Worldview: How to Have a Healthy Church Culture —
Developing a Culture of (Dis)Honesty"

Ephesians 4:25-32; 1 Peter 3:10-12

"Love one another earnestly from **a pure heart,** since you have been born again...." (1 Peter 1:22b-23a)

- Defining terms: Massive hindrances to delighting in God.
 - People Pleasing: A craving for approval and a fear of disapproval. You will compromise the truth so that people approve of you. An interest in the praise of men more than the commendation of God.
 - "For they loved the glory that comes from man more than the glory that comes from God" (John 12:43). "For am I now seeking the approval of man, or of God? Or am I trying to please man? If I were still trying to please man, I would not be a servant of Christ" (Galatians 1:10).
 - Flattery: A lie masquerading as encouragement. It is to praise someone so that you can have control over their lives or so that they will like you. Affirming and praising without challenging or correcting.
 - "Whoever rebukes a man will afterward find more favor than he who flatters with his tongue" (Proverbs 28:23). "A man who flatters his neighbor spreads a net for his feet" (Proverbs 29:5). "A lying tongue hates its victims, and a flattering mouth works ruin" (Proverbs 26:28).
 - Confession of Sin: Honesty and purity of heart involve continual admission of sin to appropriate people in our lives. At times, we believe confession of our sin is optional, not necessary.
 - "Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy" (Proverbs 28:13). "Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed" (James 5:16a).
- Ephesians 4:25-32
 - Because we are new (Ephesians 4:20-24) the way that we communicate and interact with each other is drastically different from the world.
 - The Christian community is **a community of truth**. We speak the truth in love with one another and we live the truth towards one another (Ephesians 4:15).
 - When we lie to one another we are *hurting ourselves and one another spiritually*. We are injuring our own bodies.
 - There is to be no corrupting (rotten, putrid, decay, foul) talk coming out of our mouths. "For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks." (Matthew 12:34b)
 - Our speech within the body of Christ is meant to **build up and give grace**. We encourage (1 Thessalonians 5:11) and wound one another. "Better is open rebuke than hidden love. Faithful are the wounds of a friend; profuse are the kisses of an enemy." (Proverbs 27:5-6; cf. Psalm 141:3-5)
 - The Christian community is full of kindness and tenderheartedness, especially when it comes to forgiveness. We are sinners forgiving sinners who have been forgiven by a great Savior.
