  - Israel was a vine that was to bear fruit for God's glory.
  - The sole purpose of the vine is to bear fruit for God's glory.
  - "Behold, when it was whole, it was used for nothing."
    - Before the Northern (Assyrian) and the Southern (Babylonian) Captivities the Nation was not producing fruit. How much less fruit will they produce now that they are destroyed.
  - "So have I given up the inhabitants of Jerusalem."
    - Not only were the two kingdoms taken into exile, but the city of Jerusalem and the Temple were going to be destroyed.
  - "I will make the land desolate, because they have acted faithlessly."
    - God will make it clear to the surrounding nations that they have rejected God's purpose for them.
- Isaiah 5:1-7:
  - "And He looked for it to yield grapes, but it yielded wild grapes."
  - "What more was there to do for My vineyard?"
  - "And He looked for justice....for righteousness."
- Matthew 21:33-44:
  - The *master of the house* is God the Father.
  - The *vineyard* is the Nation of Israel.
  - The *servants* are His prophets.
  - The *son* is Jesus Christ.
  - The *tenants* are the leaders of Israel.
  - The other tenants are the Church.
