"For you are **a people holy** to the LORD your God. The **LORD your God has chosen** you to be a people for **His treasured possession**, out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth." (Deuteronomy 7:6)

"Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth; for the LORD has spoken: Children have I reared and brought up, but they have rebelled against Me. The ox knows its owner, and the donkey its master's crib, but Israel does not know, My people do not understand." (Isaiah 1:2-3)

- "But you trusted in your beauty and played the whore" (16:15-22): This points to the idolatrous practices of the Nation (1 Kings 11:6-8).
- "You also played the whore with the Egyptians....you played the whore also with the Assyrians" (16:23-29): Instead of looking to God for protection they looked to Egypt and Assyria (Isaiah 30:1-7; Hosea 5:13,8:9).
- "You gave payment, while no payment was given to you" (16:30-34): They gave the wealth God had given them to foreign nations, again for protection (2 Kings 16:8-9).
