"Because Your Heart is Proud" Ezekiel 28:1-19; Jeremiah 9:23-26

"They answered Him, 'Abraham is our father.' Jesus said to them, 'If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did.... You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires." (John 8:39,44a). "But He turned and said to Peter, 'Get behind Me, Satan! You are a hindrance to Me. For you are not setting your mind on the things of God, but on the things of man." (Matthew 16:23). "Following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience." (Ephesians 2:2)

"Then He will say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels." (Matthew 25:41)

"The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, **against the LORD and against His Anointed**, saying, 'Let us burst their bonds apart and cast away their cords from us.'" (Psalm 2:2-3)

- Ezekiel was called to lament over the king and the people of Tyre. "I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked." (Ezekiel 33:11)
 - The King of Tyre was Ithobal 2nd, and he was a representative of the pride and self-sufficiency of the people of Tyre.
 - Ithobal and the people of Tyre would have considered him a "god." God will show him and the people of Tyre that this is not the case.
 - In Chapter 27 there is a strong emphasis on the economic power and success of the city of Tyre. Their abundance and blessings has led to pride (Ezekiel 27:3b,12-25).
 - The Phoenicians like the Israelites practiced circumcision (Ezekiel 28:10).
- The king of Tyre (Ezekiel 28:12-17) & The king of Babylon (Isaiah 14:12-14)
 - "Your heart is proud" (Ezekiel 28:2,17).
 - "You claimed to be a god" (Ezekiel 28:2; Isaiah 14:13-14)
 - "You were a man of wisdom" (Ezekiel 28:3,12)
 - "You were were surrounded by great wealth/beauty" (Ezekiel 28:5, 12-13)
 - These stones are associated with the presence of God, both in the description of the priest's garments (Exodus 28:17-20) and in heaven (Revelation 21:19-21).
 - Fire (Ezekiel 28:14) is often associated with being in the presence of God or even with God Himself (Hebrews 12:29; Deuteronomy 4:24; Exodus 3:2; Leviticus 9:24; Acts 2:3-4).
 - "You were corrupted from your proud heart" (Ezekiel 28:2,5-6,17)
 - "You lost your splendor" (Ezekiel 28:7,16-17; Isaiah 14:12)
