"Where is Your Security?" Ezekiel 29:1-21

"Thus says the LORD: 'Cursed is the man who trusts in man and makes flesh his strength, whose heart turns away from the LORD." (Jeremiah 17:5). "Ah, stubborn children,' declares the LORD, 'who carry out a plan, but not Mine, and who make an alliance, but not of My Spirit, that they may add sin to sin; who set out to go down to Egypt, without asking for My direction, to take refuge in the protection of Pharaoh and to seek shelter in the shadow of Egypt!" (Isaiah 30:1-2)

"The righteous shall see and fear, and shall laugh at him saying, 'See the man who would not make God his refuge, but **trusted in the abundance of his riches** and sought refuge in his own destruction!" (Psalm 52:6-7) "Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help and **rely on** horses, **who trust in** chariots because they **are many** and in horsemen because they are **very strong**, but do not look to the Holy One of Israel or consult the LORD!" (Isaiah 31:1)

- The Accusation (Ezekiel 29:1-9) The date of this prophecy is January 7th, 587 BC and the date of Ezekiel 29:17-21 is 571 BC.
 - After the time of Joseph, Egypt was a constant enemy of the nation of Israel (Exodus 1:8-14).
 - Pharaoh Hophra is making the claim that he is the source of the economic and agricultural success of Egypt. Even going as far to say that he made the Nile River.
 - There were times of cooperation and peace between Egypt and Israel. King Solomon had married an Egyptian princess (1 Kings 11:1-8); Egypt had temporarily driven Babylon away from their siege on Jerusalem (Jeremiah 43:8-13; 46:25-28); and Egypt would periodically try to recruit Israel in their battles with Assyria and Babylon; lastly during the reigns of Jehoiakim (Jeremiah 46), Hezekiah (Isaiah 30), and Zedekiah (Jeremiah 37:1-10).
 - (29:5) The Egyptians made much of their dead Pharaohs in mummification, pyramid construction, and large endowments for sacrifices.
 - (29:6-7) Egypt was known for not following through with the alliances that they made with other nations (Isaiah 36:6; 2 Kings 18:21).
- The Consequence (Ezekiel 29:10-20)
 - o (29:11) The period of time between Nebuchadnezzer's conquest of Egypt and Cyrus' conquest of Babylon was about 40 years (Ezra 1:1-4).
 - (29:17-20) Tyre had sent away their wealth so that Babylon could not have it. The siege of Tyre had not been materially beneficial.
 - (29:15) Egypt would be humbled and never have the dominance that they had during this period of time.
 - (29:19-20) We again see the sovereignty of God over the nations working according to God's purposes (Daniel 2:20-21).
- The Confirmation (Ezekiel 29:21)
 - "Israel again would return to their land, and when they see these prophecies come to pass, Ezekiel's words would be taken more seriously. Prophecy was meant to glorify the knowledge and power of God, to warn and comfort the people, and to give confidence and boldness in speaking for God to the people and His Word does the same today." (Charles Feinberg)
