"The Watchman and the Shepherds" (Part 3) Ezekiel 34:11-24

"My servant David **shall be king over them**, and they shall all have one shepherd. They shall walk in My rules and be careful to obey My statutes. They shall **dwell in the land** that I gave to My servant Jacob, where your fathers lived. They and their children and their children's children shall dwell there forever, and **David My**servant shall be their prince forever." (Ezekiel 37:24-25)

"Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, and he shall reign as king and deal wisely, and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.  - "And the Lord said to Samuel, 'Obey the voice of the people in all that they say to you, for they
 have not rejected you, but they have rejected Me from being king over them." (1 Samuel
 8:7)
 - "He said, 'These will be the ways of the king who will reign over you: he will take....'(6 times)"
 (1 Samuel 8:11)
 - "And they said, 'No! But there shall be a king over us, that we also may be like all the nations, and that our king may judge us and go out before us and fight our battles." (1 Samuel 8:19-20)
