"Why Will There Be a Priesthood in the Millennial Kingdom?" (Part 2) Ezekiel 40-48 (Hebrews 9:11-15)

- Christ's Priesthood brings us near to God:
 - "Let us then with confidence **draw near** to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)
 - "Consequently, He is able to save to the uttermost those who **draw near to God** through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them." (Hebrews 7:25)
 - "And since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water." (Hebrews 10:21-22)
- Christ's Priesthood offered a supreme sacrifice Hebrews 9:9,22;10:3-4
 - "But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, He sat down at the right hand of God....For by a single offering He has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified." (Hebrews 10:12,14)
 - "How much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God." (Hebrews 9:14)
- Christ was a sinless High Priest Hebrews 5:2-3
 - "For we do not have **a high priest** who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, **yet without sin**." (Hebrews 4:15)
 - "Therefore He had to be made like His brothers in every respect, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people." (Hebrews 2:17)
 - "For it was indeed fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, innocent, unstained, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. He has no need, like those high priests, to offer sacrifices daily, first for His own sins, and then for those of the people, since He did this once for all when He offered up Himself." (Hebrews 7:26-27)
- Christ has a permanent priesthood as High Priest:
 - "The former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office, but He holds His priesthood permanently, because He continues forever." (Hebrews 7:23-24)
 - "Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer any offering for sin." (Hebrews 10:18)
- Christ's work guarantees the New Covenant Salvifically and Nationally Hebrews 7:22
- Christ's Priesthood was based on an oath or a promise, not the law:
 - "Who has become a priest, not on the basis of a legal requirement concerning bodily descent, but by the power of an indestructible life." (Hebrews 7:16)
 - "The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind, You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek." (Psalm 110:4; cf. Hebrews 7:1-10)
