"Living in Light of Eternity" (Part 4) Luke 12:4-48 (Luke 12:35-48)

What is faithfulness? It is when there is consistency between what you say and what you do, between what you believe and how you behave, between what you promise and what you perform."

- We are to be ready for Christ's return:
 - "Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of people ought you to be in lives of holiness and godliness." (2 Peter 3:11); "Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these, be diligent to be found by Him without spot or blemish, and at peace." (2 Peter 3:14)
 - "And now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears we may have confidence and not shrink from Him in shame at His coming." (1 John 2:28)
 - "His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master." (Matthew 25:21)
- **Four** descriptions of preparation:
 - <u>"Stay dressed for action":</u> This was the position of one who was ready to run, work, or fight. To gird their loins or to remove obstacles from effectiveness.
 - <u>"Keep your lamps burning":</u> Biblically, light represents knowledge. We are to do life in light of the Word of God. We are not in darkness, we are in the light.
 - <u>"Servants waiting on their master":</u> Servants would be waiting for their master to return from the wedding feast. It could take up to seven days.

"Being faithful is a celebration of God's faithfulness to us, and being a servant is a celebration of Chritst's servanthood to us."

"But whoever would be great among you **must be your servant**, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man came not to be served **but to serve**, and to give His life as a ransom for many." (Mark 10:43b-45); "If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have **washed your feet**, you also ought to **wash one another's feet**." (John 13:14)

- <u>"Had known at what hour the thief was coming":</u> We need to be ready for the return of Christ by salvation and sanctification.
- The faithful servant. (Luke 12:31-34,41-44)
 - He was faithful with his earthly things with eternity in mind. "The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with Him in order that we may also be glorified with Him." (Romans 8:16-17)
- The unfaithful servant. (Luke 12:18-21,45-48)
 - He did not live as if the Word of God was true. "For what does it profit a man if he gains the whole world and loses or forfeits himself?" (Luke 9:25)
