The Gog and Magog War (Pt.1) Ezekiel 38

The 5 W's

What:

This is a <u>literal future war</u> that is going to take place. There are theologians who interpret this symbolically, and say that this is just a representation of the forces that are against God and His kingdom, and one day they will be defeated, but this text needs to be interpreted literally.

Who:

Gog, of Magog, chief prince of Rosh, Meshech and Tubal (vs. 2-3). They will come from their place out of the uttermost parts of the north (vs.15). Magog - These are the ancient Scythians, who settled to the north of the Black and Caspian Seas. Rosh - Also known as the "Ros" people. In Ezekiel's day, these people settled in modern day Russia, where they stayed. Meshech and Tubal are modern day Turkey. Persia is modern day Iran, Cush is Sudan and Ethiopia, Put was located in modern day Libya, and both Gomer and Beth-togarmah were known to have settled in Turkey.

Where:

Vs.21 "I will summon a sword against Gog on *all my mountains*, declares the Lord God." This war is going to take place on the mountains of Israel, in their own land.

When:

This war will take place after the rapture of the Church. Once the church is out of the way, the Antichrist will be set to make a 7 year peace treaty with Israel. This is the beginning of the Tribulation. Vs. 38:10-11,14,16 show us that Israel will be dwelling securely, with no need for walls, bars or gates. The way this will be brought about is a false sense of peace that comes from the treaty with the Antichrist.

Why:

<u>Human Agency</u>: vs.10-13 shows us that these nations desire the riches that Israel possesses. The Dead Sea, with the sheer amount of mineral deposits, would be useful for any country to have access to. On top of this, the world may have started to go through at least some of the Seal Judgements described in Revelation 6:1-17. This would be enough cause for world powers to take drastic action.

God's Sovereignty: God knew exactly what thoughts would come into Gog's mind (38:10, John 2:24-25. 1 Chronicles 28:9, Jeremiah 17:10). Gog is responsible for his own actions, but God providentially brings this about (38:2-4, Proverbs 21:1, Gen 50:20).

The Outcome:

First, a massive earthquake (vs. 19), Second, anarchy and fear (vs. 20). Third, Mass confusion for Gog's army (vs.21). Lastly, hailstones, fire and sulfur will rain down to finish off Gog's army (vs. 22)
