"The Christian Work Ethic: The Sluggard" (Part 1) Proverbs 24:30-34

"A slothful man may be a very busy man. He is a man who goes through the motions, who flies on automatic pilot. Like a man with a bad head cold, he has mostly lost his sense of taste and smellpeople come and go, but through glazed eyes he hardly notices them. He is letting things run their course. He is getting through his life. He loves what makes him comfortable, not what makes him like Christ."

- Observations from Proverbs 24:30-34:
 - The slothful man lacks wisdom, that is, he thinks unbiblically.
 - We are to meditate on the consequences of being slothful.
 - Slothfulness is a "patient and silent" assassin.
 - Slothfulness and hard work are self-evident.
- 3 Categories of Slothfulness: "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart (spiritual) and with all your soul (emotions) and with all your mind and with all your strength (physical)." (Mark 12:30)
 - Spiritual Slothfulness: "Do not be slothful in zeal (passion), be fervent in spirit (to persevere), serve the Lord (make it about Him)." (Romans 12:11)
 - "Slothfulness in Christianity not only prevents us from glorifying God but it also allows evil to prosper in our lives. For the weeds of slothfulness to prosper the gardener only needs to leave the garden alone."
 - Emotional Slothfulness: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Phillipians 4:6-7)
 - Physical Slothfulness: "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ." (Colossians 3:23-24)
- Slothfulness or Sluggardness 101:
 - "The desire of the sluggard kills him, for his hands refuse to labor. All day long he craves and craves, but the righteous gives and does not hold back." (Proverbs 21:25-26)
 - "The sluggard is wiser in his own eyes than seven men who can answer sensibly." (Proverbs 26:16)
 - "A slack hand causes poverty, but the hand of the diligent makes rich. He who gathers in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps in harvest is a son who brings shame." (Proverbs 10:4-5)
 - "The soul of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, while the soul of the diligent is richly supplied." (Proverbs 13:4-5)
 - "Like vinegar to the teeth and smoke to the eyes, so is the sluggard to those who send him." (Proverbs 10:26)
 - "The way of a sluggard is like a hedge of thorns, but the path of the upright is a level highway."
 (Proverbs 15:19)
