- Proverbs 1:8-19:
 - "Graceful garland" and "pendants" are another way of saying "put on the Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 13:14) or to "let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works." (Matthew 5:16)
 - Holiness adorns our lives with beauty (Titus 2:10; 1 Peter 3:4).
 - Sinners "love being simple, they delight in their scoffing, and they hate knowledge." (Proverbs 1:22)
 - Everyone is searching for treasure (Proverbs 1:13; Proverbs 2:4-5). We search with the compass of covetousness or we search with the compass of God's wisdom. (Proverbs 1:19)
 - "But godliness with contentment is great gain....For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evils. It is through this craving that some have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many pangs." (1 Timothy 6:6,10)
 - "Such are the paths of all who forget God; the hope of the godless shall perish." (Job 8:13)
 - There is "fleeting pleasures of sin" (Hebrews 11:25) but in the end is death. There is temporal loss in holiness but in the end is life.
 - "Turn away from evil (do not be enticed) and do good; seek peace and pursue it." (Psalm 34:14)
 - "There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death." (Proverbs 16:25)
- We never outgrow our need for submission to man and need of one another:
 - "Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right." (Ephesians 6:1). "Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, as you would Christ." (Ephesians 6:5). "Let every person be subject to the governing authorities." (Romans 13:1). "Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls." (Hebrews 13:17)
 - "If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together." (1 Corinthians 12:26). "When each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love." (Ephesians 4:16b). "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another." (1 Peter 4:10a)
