

“Have You Received the Inexpressible Gift?”  
2 Corinthians 9:10-15

**If something is inexpressible**, the emotion is too strong to be expressed in words. It is too intense or great to be accurately or adequately described. Something so profound that language fails to capture it.

**All Christian giving** is to be an act of worship that flows from our thankfulness for the inexpressible gift. From Christmas morning, to birthday celebrations, to corporate worship on Sunday, all giving is to be about Christ and because of what Christ has given.

“If God’s love, grace, and generosity doesn’t baffle us, we have not yet come to truly understand the magnitude of these realities.”

- Unwrapping the Gift:
  - **Eternal life:** *“For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (Romans 6:23)*
  - **Forgiveness of sins:** *“In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace.” (Ephesians 1:7)*
  - **Righteousness:** *“For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God.” (2 Corinthians 5:21)*
  - **A New Creation:** *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come.” (2 Corinthians 5:17)*
  - **The Love of Christ:** *“For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that in Christ Jesus our Lord.” (Romans 8:38-39)*
  - **Generosity:** *“You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God.” (2 Corinthians 9:11)*
  - **Jesus Christ Himself:** *“Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For His sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ.” (Philippians 3:8)*

  - *“Whoever does not believe God has made Him a liar, because he has not believed in the testimony that God has borne concerning His Son. And this is the testimony, that God gave us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.” (1 John 5:10b-11)*
