

“The Gospel According to Luke:
What Does the Bible Say About Hell and Is Hell Eternal?”
Luke 16:19-31

“Neither a cavalier attitude toward the lost nor a compassionate compromise on the Biblical teachings on Hell are appropriate for a subject of such grave importance.” (Richard Mayhue)

*“Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with your might, for there is no work or thought or knowledge or wisdom **in Sheol**, to which you are going.” (Ecclesiastes 9:10). “And **in Hades**, being in **torment**, he lifted up his eyes and saw Abraham far off and Lazarus at his side.” (Luke 16:23). “But now [Lazarus] is **comforted** here (**Abraham’s side**), and you are in anguish.” (Luke 16:25c). “[Who] was caught up to **the third heaven....** And I know that this man was caught up into **paradise....**” (2 Corinthians 12:2-3; cf. Philippians 1:21-23). “Then **Death and Hades** were thrown into **the lake of fire**. This is **the second death**, the lake of fire. And if anyone’s name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.” (Revelation 20:14-15)*

- Hades/Lake of Fire is a place of Justice and Judgment:
 - “He (God) will render to each one according to his works: but for those who are self seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, there will be **wrath and fury**.” (Romans 2:6,8; cf. Luke 16:24)
 - “Or do you presume on the riches of His kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God’s kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?” (Romans 2:4; cf. Luke 16:25)
 - “But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are **storing up wrath** for yourself on the day of wrath when **God’s righteous judgment** will be revealed.” (Romans 2:5; cf. Luke 16:29-31)
- Hades/Lake of Fire is a place of separation from the grace of God (sin restrained and kindness extended).
 - “They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His might.” (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
 - “And throw them into the fiery furnace. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.” (Matthew 13:42)
 - “Where their worm does not die and the fire is not quenched.” (Mark 9:48; Isaiah 66:24)
 - “For whom the gloom of utter darkness has been reserved forever.” (Jude 1:13b)
- Hades/Lake of Fire is eternal, not temporal.
 - “And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to **everlasting life**, and some to shame and **everlasting contempt**.” (Daniel 12:2)
 - “And these will go away into **eternal punishment**, but the righteous into **eternal life**.” (Matthew 25:46)
 - “And the smoke of **their torment goes up forever and ever**, and they have no rest, day or night, these worshippers of the beast and its image, and whoever receives the mark of its name.” (Revelation 14:11)
