

“The Gospel According to Luke: When Jesus Weeps  
Luke 19:41-44

*“For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.” (Philippians 3:18-19). “(For) I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh.” (Romans 9:2-3). “My eyes shed streams of tears, because people do not keep Your law.” (Psalm 119:136)*

- **“When He drew near and saw the city, He wept over it.”:**
  - *“O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing!” (Luke 13:34)*
  - *“This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me; in vain do they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.” (Matthew 15:8-9)*
  - *“He came to His own, and His own people did not receive Him.” (John 1:11)*
- **“The things that make for peace!”:**
  - *“But now in Christ Jesus you who were once far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.” (Ephesians 2:13)*
  - *“Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.” (Romans 5:1)*
  - *“Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making His appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.” (2 Corinthians 5:20)*
- **“But now they are hidden from your eyes.”:**
  - *“‘You will indeed hear but never understand, and you will indeed see but never perceive.’ For this people’s heart has grown dull, and with their ears they can barely hear, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears and understand with their heart and turn, and I would heal them. But blessed are your eyes, for they see, and your ears, for they hear.” (Matthew 13:14-16)*
  - *“Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes.” (Matthew 11:21)*
- **“For the days will come upon you.”:**
  - In 70 AD 600,000 Jews were killed and the temple, the Jewish place of worship, was destroyed. This judgment was directly related to their rejection of Christ and points to the ultimate consequence of rebellion and rejection of Christ, eternal separation from God.
  - *“How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace?” (Hebrews 10:29)*
