

“The Gospel According to Luke: Jesus, the All-Knowing, All-Powerful King”

Luke 19:28-40

What is God’s Omniscience? *God possesses complete and infinite knowledge. This is the knowledge of all things past, present, and future, and all possibilities. It is God’s knowledge of all things, at all times, about all things, without limit.*

“For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, ‘My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all My purpose.’” (Isaiah 46:9b-10). “God is greater than our heart, and He knows everything.” (1 John 3:20b).

“Great is our Lord, and abundant in power; His understanding is beyond measure.” (Psalm 147:5)

What is God’s Omnipotence?: *God’s ability and power to do all things that are consistent with His will and His nature. God is not limited by anything outside of Himself.*

“Our God is in the heavens; He does all that He pleases.” (Psalm 115:3). “(God), I know that You can do all things, and that no purpose of Yours can be thwarted.” (Job 42:2). “What is impossible with man is possible with God.” (Luke 18:27). “Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and how inscrutable His ways.” (Romans 11:33)

● **Prophecy Fulfilled and Prophecy Given:**

- *“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is He, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.” (Zechariah 9:9; cf. Matthew 21:5; 1 Kings 1:38,44)*
- *“And after the sixty-two weeks, an anointed one (Jesus) shall be cut off and have nothing (be crucified). And the people of the prince who is to come (The Romans) shall destroy the city (Jerusalem) and the sanctuary (The Temple).” (Daniel 9:26)*

● **The King Comes to Jerusalem:**

- *“Then in haste every man of them took his garment and put it under him on the bare steps, and they blew the trumpet and proclaimed, ‘Jehu is King.’” (2 Kings 9:13)*
- *“After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, ‘Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!’” (Revelation 7:9-10)*
- *“Hosanna (Save Now) to the Son of David (The Messiah)! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest.” (Matthew 21:9; cf. Psalm 118:25-26). “Blessed is the coming kingdom (earthly, not spiritual) of our father David! Hosanna in the highest.” (Mark 11:10). “Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!” (John 12:13)*

● **The Stones Cry Out:**

- *“For the stone will cry out from the wall, and the beam from the woodwork respond. ‘Woe to him who builds a town with blood and founds a city on iniquity! Behold, is it not from the LORD of hosts that people labor merely for fire, and nations weary themselves for nothing?’” (Habakkuk 2:11-13)*
