

“What Are You Living For?”
Luke 20:27-40

- The Sadducees:
 - *“For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, nor angel, nor spirit (soul without the body), but the Pharisees acknowledge them all.” (Acts 23:8)*
 - *“But the high priest rose up, and all who were with him (that is, the party of the Sadducees), and filled with jealousy they arrested the apostles and put them in the public prison.” (Acts 5:17-18)*
 - *“Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth....but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven....for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” (Matthew 6:19-21)*

- Levirate (a husband's brother) Marriage:
 - *“If brothers dwell together, and one of them dies and has no son, the wife of the dead man shall not be married outside the family to a stranger. Her husband's brother shall go in to her and take her as his wife and perform the duty of a husband's brother to her. And the first son whom she bears shall succeed to the name of his dead brother, that his name may not be blotted out of Israel.” (Deuteronomy 25:5-6)*

- Luke 20:27-40:
 - *“But Jesus answered them, ‘You are wrong, because you know neither the Scriptures nor the power of God.’” (Matthew 22:29)*
 - *“For I know that my Redeemer lives, and at last He will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been thus destroyed, yet in my flesh I shall see God.” (Job 19:25-26)*
 - *“And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.” (Daniel 12:2; cf. John 11:23-26)*
 - *“They neither marry nor are given in marriage, for they cannot die anymore....”*
 - There will be no need for marriage/child bearing because no one will die in heaven or on the New Earth.
 - Jesus is brilliantly dismantling the Sadducees' theology. He is affirming the resurrection, the reality of angels (Genesis 19:1,5; 28:12; 32:1), and that we have eternal souls (Exodus 3). He does this by using the writings of Moses/Pentateuch.
 - Jesus made the claim that Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were alive in Moses' day!
 - ***“For they no longer dared to ask Him any question.” (Luke 20:40)***

- Our Resurrected Bodies: (1 Corinthians 15:42-44)
 - ***They are imperishable:*** They will no longer experience sickness or disease, deterioration, or death.
 - ***They are glorious:*** We will please, praise, and enjoy God willingly and perfectly.
 - ***They are powerful:*** Weakness and limitation will not keep us from enjoying God and creation.
 - ***They are spiritual:*** We will not be dependent on natural means for life but instead we will be dependent on spiritual means.
