

"Do This In Remembrance of Me"
Luke 22:7-21

*"Behold, **the Lamb of God**, who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29); "Cleanse out the old leaven that you may be a new lump, **as you really are unleavened**. For **Christ, our Passover lamb**, has been sacrificed. Let us therefore **celebrate the festival**, not with the old leaven, the leaven of malice and evil, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."* (1 Corinthians 5:7-8)

- Luke 22:7-23:
 - **"Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat it..."**
 - "Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God at the place He will choose: at the Feast of Unleavened Bread...they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed." (Deuteronomy 16:16)
 - "And you shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Egypt. Therefore you shall observe this day, throughout your generations, as a statute forever." (Exodus 12:17)
 - **"I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer..."**
 - "No one takes it (His life) from Me, but I lay it down of My own accord. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This charge I have received from My Father." (John 10:18)
 - "Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:2)
 - **"For I tell you I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God..."**
 - "And I assign to you, as My Father assigned to Me, a kingdom, that you may eat and drink at My table in My kingdom and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel." (Luke 22:29)
 - "Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)
 - **"This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me."**
 - "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed." (1 Peter 2:24)
 - "For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God." (2 Corinthians 5:21)
 - **"This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood."**
 - "In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace." (Ephesians 1:7)
 - "For this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." (Matthew 26:28)
